

**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 13**  
*Series of 2011*

**"MANILA BAY CLEAN UP, REHABILITATION AND  
 PRESERVATION INSPECTION AND MONITORING  
 TEAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LUBAO"**

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with the Supreme Court En Banc Decision in the case of *MMDA vs. Concerned Residents of Manila Bay*, G.R. Nos. 171947-48, dated December 18, 2008, all local government units (LGUs) in Metro Manila, Rizal, Laguna, Cavite, Bulacan, Pampanga, and Bataan are directed to inspect all factories, commercial establishments, and private homes along the banks of the major river systems in their respective areas of jurisdiction, such as, but not limited to, the Pasig-Marikina-San Juan Rivers, Tullahan-Tenejeros Rivers, the Meycauayan-Marilao-Obando (Bulacan) Rivers, the Talisay (Bataan) River, the Imus (Cavite) River, the Laguna De Bay, and other minor rivers and waterways that eventually discharge water into the Manila Bay; and the lands abutting the bay, to determine whether they have wastewater treatment facilities or hygienic septic tanks as prescribed by existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations. If none be found, these LGUs shall be ordered to require non-complying establishments and homes to set up said facilities or septic tanks within a reasonable time to prevent industrial wastes, sewage water, and human wastes from flowing into these rivers, waterways, *esteros*, and the Manila Bay, under pain of closure or imposition of fines and other sanctions;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said directive, there is a need for a monitoring team to oversee and coordinate the planning and rehabilitation efforts for the development of Manila Bay;

**NOW, THEREFORE I, ROBERTITO V. DIAZ**, Acting Municipal Mayor of Lubao, Pampanga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the law, do hereby order the following:

**Section 1. Creation of the Lubao Inspection, Inventory and Monitoring Team.** – There is hereby created the Lubao Inspection, Inventory and Monitoring Team under the Office of the Mayor.

**Section 2. Composition.** – The Lubao Inspection, Inventory and Monitoring Team shall be composed but not limited to the following:

**Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities.** – The Lubao inspection, inventory and monitoring team shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Conduct inspection and inventory of all factories, commercial establishments and private homes within and outside the easement along shorelines and banks of major and minor river system and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

2. Prepare and submit a duly certified list of the following not later than September 30, 2011:

a. List of names and addresses of all non-complying factories, commercial establishments and private homes along the shorelines and banks of major and minor river system and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

b. List of names and addresses of all private homes along the shorelines and banks of major and minor river system and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

c. List names and addresses of the informal settlers in their respective areas, who as of September 30, 2011, own or occupy houses, structures, constructions and other encroachments built along the shorelines and banks of major and minor river system and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

3. Monitor the compliance of non-complying factories, commercial establishments and private homes along the shorelines and banks of major and minor river systems and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

4. Recommend the imposition of necessary sanctions and penalties to the Local Chief Executive of all non-complying factories, commercial establishments and private homes along the shorelines and banks of major and minor river systems and waterways within the Manila Bay Watershed Area.

5. Prepare and submit Quarterly Report on Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) compliance and LGU Five Year Action Plan Implementation starting June 2011 and December 2011 respectively.

6. Perform other task that maybe assigned from time to time relative to the implementation of the Manila Bay Clean Up, Rehabilitation and Preservation Inspection Project.

**Section 4. Technical and Secretariat Support.** – The Office of the Municipal Planning and Development Office and the Municipal Engineering Office shall provide the necessary technical and secretarial support and shall also serve as the Program Management Office of the Monitoring Team.

**Section 5. Funding.** – The funds necessary for the implementation of this Executive Order shall be sourced by the Municipal Budget Office in coordination with the Monitoring Team.

**Section 6. Effectivity.** – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
