-MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-2020-

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE OF PAYMENT AND SUSPENDING
THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES, INTERESTS AND SURCHARGES IN THE
REVENUE-GENERATING ACTIVITIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY, SUBJECT TO
EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Sponsor: All Sangguniang Bayan Members

WHEREAS, Section 167 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sanggunian concerned may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the time of payment of such taxes, fees, or charges without penalties, surcharges and interests but only for a period not exceeding six (6) months;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Proclamation No. 922 dated March 8, 2020 issued by His Excellency President Rodrigo Roa-Duterte declaring a Public Health Emergency in the entire country mandated that all government agencies and local government units to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the COVID-19 threat;

WHEREAS, in the light of the Proclamation No. 929 dated March 16, 2020 issued by His Excellency President Rodrigo Roa-Duterte declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, under Sangguniang Bayan Municipal Resolution No.64-2020 dated March 17, 2020 declares that the Municipality of Lubao in a State of Calamity pursuant to Section 458 of the Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, considering the large number of taxpayers who will converge to the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) of the Municipality of Lubao, however public health is paramount importance, there is a imperative need to extend the deadline for the payment of business taxes, fees and charges for the 2nd Quarter of 2020;

BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF LUBAO, PAMPANGA, in regular session assembled –

SECTION 1. Coverage. The Business License, 2nd Quarter payment without penalty shall be extended until April 30, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. only (instead of April 20, 2020). Likewise, there shall be no additional 2% penalty which will be imposed for the month of March. All payments are extended until April 30, 2020.

For Fees and Charges, all payment deadlines that fall within the Enhanced Community Quarantine shall be extended until April 30, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. only.

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is declared not valid by a court of competent jurisdiction or suspended by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, such judgement shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, section or parts thereof and shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, executive orders, implementing rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and completion of the publication requirements.


